Date	Number of Days	Action
January 4, 2012 <i>Wednesday</i>	90 Days	LAST DAY for any changes in the boundaries of election precincts. FIRST DAY applications for absentee ballots may be filed in writing with the municipal clerk.
February 10, 2012 <i>Friday</i>	51 Days	LAST DAY for clerk to prepare the petition forms for nomination.
February 13, 2012 <i>Monday</i>	50 Days	FIRST DAY that nomination petitions may be circulated.
	Within 10 Days after petition received	Candidates must file Fair Campaign Practices Act
February 17, 2012 <i>Friday</i>	46 Days	LAST DAY to file written comments concerning TABOR issues to be included in the issue mailing.
February 21, 2012 <i>Tuesday</i>	43 Days	LAST DAY for petition representatives to file with Clerk summary of comments in favor of their TABOR petition.
March 2, 2012 <i>Friday</i>	31 Days	LAST DAY a person can move from one precinct to another and be eligible to vote in new precinct.
March 5, 2012 <i>Monday</i>	30 Days	LAST DAY that nomination petitions may be circulated and signed prior to the regular election. LAST DAY for nomination petitions to be filed with the municipal clerk. LAST DAY to mail TABOR Ballot Issue to all "Registered households"
March 5, 2012 <i>Monday</i>	30 Days	LAST DAY to register to vote LAST DAY for the County Clerk to submit to the DEO a complete list of registered electors.
March 5, 2012 <i>Monday</i>	30 Days	LAST DAY that a person can move into a municipal election precinct and become a resident for purposes of voting. All petitions and nominations that are in apparent conformity with the Municipal Election Code, as determined by the municipal clerk, are valid unless there is a written objection within three days after the filing of the nomination petition. Notice of the objection must be mailed "forthwith" to the affected candidate. The municipal clerk must determine the validity of the objection within at least 48 hours after it is filed. Any sustained objection may be remedied or any defect cured

		by an amendment to the original petition, or by filing a new petition within three days after the objection is sustained and no later than the 18 th day before the election.
March 5, 2012 <i>Monday</i>	29 Days	An elector shall be permitted to vote who is registered to vote no later than 29 days before an election. FIRST DAY a registered elector may file an affidavit of change of address within the municipality with the county clerk in order to vote at a new residence.
March 6, 2012 <i>Tuesday</i>	28 Days	Municipal clerk delivers to the office of the county clerk, in person, the new registration sheets for those persons who live within the county in which the municipality is located and who is registered with the municipal clerk.
March 9, 2012 <i>Friday</i>	24 Days	LAST DAY to withdraw from nomination.
March 9, 2012 <i>Friday</i>	23 Days	LAST DAY that nomination petitions that do not contain the requisite number of names of electors qualified to sign the petition can be amended in this respect prior to the election. If any candidate should die or withdraw from the nomination prior to 23 days before the election, the vacancy may be filled by the vacancy committee.
March 13, 2012 <i>Tuesday</i>	21 Days	If the governing body has so approved by ordinance, no write-in vote for any municipal office shall be counted unless an affidavit of intent has been filed with the clerk prior to 20 days before the day of the election by the person whose name is to be written in indicating that such person desires the office and is qualified to assume the duties of that office if elected. Contribution reports required by the Fair Campaign Practices Act to be filed with the municipal clerk must be filed on the twenty-first day and on the Friday before (March 30th) and thirty days (May 3rd) after the election.
March 14, 2012 <i>Wednesday</i>	20 Days	LAST DAY to file any petition or certificate of nomination to fill a vacancy with the municipal clerk. TABOR NOTICE on debt question must be posted; on WEBSITE also.
March 16, 2012 <i>Friday</i>	18 Days	If an ordinance has been adopted by the governing body pursuant to Section 31-10-306, the clerk may cancel the election and declare the candidates elected upon a resolution by the governing body if the election of persons to office is the only matter before the voters, and if, at the close of business on the 19th day (March 15) before election, there are not more candidates than offices to be filled at such election, including write-in candidates filing

		affidavits of intent. In the event of such cancellation, notice of cancellation shall be published, if possible, and notice of cancellation must be posted at each polling place and in at least one other public place.
March 19, 2012 <i>Monday</i>	15 Days	LAST DAY for the Board of Trustees to appoint election judges or to delegate to the Clerk the authority and responsibility to appoint election judges.
March 22, 2012 <i>Thursday</i>	12 Days	LAST DAY for voting equipment to be available for the election if electronic voting machines are used.
March 23, 2012 <i>Friday</i>	10Days	LAST DAY to designate polling place with sign. LAST DAY for sample and official ballots for the election to be printed and in the possession of the clerk. Sample ballots shall be available for public inspection.
March 29, 2012 <i>Thursday</i>	5 Days	LAST DAY for the county clerk to prepare, certify and deliver a copy of the complete list of registered electors. Obtain list from County Clerk. (Supplemental List)
March 30, 2012 <i>Friday</i>	Friday before election	LAST DAY for applications for absentee ballots to be filed with the municipal clerk. LAST DAY to vote via walk-in absentee ballot. Contribution reports required by the Fair Campaign Practices Act must be filed with the municipal clerk. Voting is available from opening to close of business day for absentee voters. EMERGENCY only after deadline.
April 2, 2012 <i>Monday</i>	1 Day before election	LAST DAY for election judges to obtain list of all registered voters. LAST DAY for voting supplies to be delivered to precincts.
April 3, 2012 <i>Tuesday</i>	Election Day	(No later than 8:30am) , Clerk must deliver the absent voter envelopes in a sealed package and a list of absent voters. Absent voter ballots received after 8:30am should be delivered to judges up to 7:00 pm
April 3, 2012 <i>Tuesday</i>	Election Day	LAST DAY for registered electors to file an affidavit of change of address with the county clerk. LAST DAY (before 7:00 PM) for requests for absentee and emergency absentee ballots to be filed with the municipal clerk.
