2011 DOG LICENSES

All dogs beyond the age of three months within the town limits are required to be licensed annually. The Town of Green Mountain Falls issues its own licenses. Fees are: **\$12.00** for a neutered/spayed dog and **\$20.00** for a dog that is not neutered or spayed.

If your dog does not need a rabies shot at the time of the license renewal date, obtain the license and call in the rabies number to us when you get it. In some instances, rabies vaccinations are good for three years--your vet can advise you.

Please contact the Town Hall at 684-9414 to obtain a 2011 license. We can handle most of the licensing process through the mail if that works compatibly with your schedule. Town Hall is open from 8:30 am to 5:00 pm on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday; closed Wednesdays. I have enclosed a registration form to help expedite the process.

REMINDER: The Town has a leash ordinance-dogs cannot run at large. There are many reasons for the restrictions- one being the large population of wildlife in our community. Please use the pet pickup bags provided in the Town parks. The parks and streets are becoming permeated with dog "offerings".

◆ **NOTE:** Town Code Section 7-147 states that it shall be unlawful to keep more than two (2) dogs at any household.

If you no longer have a dog, please let us know (leave a message on the answering machine) so that we can update our records and not pester you with mailings. Thank you.
